Possible Mass Schedule Alteration:

As you may have heard, Fr. Mel Byrne has been asked by his order to return to Ireland on September 4th. Sadly, he will not be able to remain here at Annunciation for the full duration of Fr. Eugene's sabbatical. While we are making every effort to obtain the services of visiting priests for at least one of our Sunday Masses, we recognize that there may be times when one will not be available. If this is the case, we will make an announcement at the Masses on the weekend before that English Masses will be celebrated that next Sunday at 7:30 and 10:30 a.m.—we will eliminate the 9:00 a.m. Mass for that particular Sunday. Secondly, if we do not have the services of a Spanish-speaking priest for any of our 12:00 Noon Masses, we will also announce this the weekend prior and Fr. Callanan will celebrate the 7:30 and 10:30 English Masses, along with the 12:00 Noon Spanish Mass. Again, we will eliminate the 9:00 a.m. Mass for that Sunday. We realize that this is inconvenient for some and we are hoping to minimize this from occurring often, but we must be realistic about our priest shortage and not overburden Fr. Callanan in Fr. Eugene's absence. We thank you in advance for your patience these next few months and welcome any suggestions you may have for locating visiting priests for our parish during this period.

Religious Education Registration:
