Church Flooring Project Has Begun:

Please be reminded that, due to the commencement of this project, all Masses and other church-related events will be moved to the Parish Hall for the estimated time period to complete the flooring, which will be from Monday, July 31st through Friday, August 25th. There will be no Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament on First Friday, August 4th; nor Anointing or Benediction that evening. We will keep you updated on the progress.

Religious Education Registration:

Registration for the 2017-2018 year began **Sunday, July 16th**. The Religious Education Office will be open Sundays from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 Noon starting on that day. Classes begin on Sept. 21st. First-year students need a Baptismal Certificate. If you are registering for Confirmation, please bring both a Baptismal and a First Communion Certificate. Families with children six years and older, who are not baptized, need to provide a copy of a birth certificate. Families returning for the second year of sacramental preparation must have all previous fees paid and copies of certificates must be in our office. Attention: Ministers Of Adoration:

To conform to church guidelines for adoration, we need to be mindful of the regulation that requires that there be **no exposition** of the Blessed Sacrament **during Mass** celebrations in the same church. That means that the Blessed Sacrament monstrance cabinet should not be opened during Sunday Morning Masses, or during any other scheduled Masses celebrated in the main church. Please take care to observe this minimum limitation to our "Perpetual" adoration. Thank you.
