National Needs Collection Next Weekend:

Next weekend, we will take up our annual collection for the National needs campaign. Your donation helps support some of the poorest dioceses in the United States, particularly those aided by the Black and Indian Home Mission. These funds also strengthen our Church at home by helping provide basic pastoral resources and services to needy ethnic communities in isolated areas through the Catholic Home Missions appeal. Some of these monies are also designated for the Catholic University of America's exceptional programs of scholarship, research and service. Church Flooring Project To Begin:

Thanks to our faithful and generous parishioners, we have now reached our fundraising goal necessary to put the new flooring in the church! This is a very labor-intensive project and will require that we allow the workers full access to the church for the duration of this project. Therefore, all Masses and other church-related events will be moved to the Parish Hall for the estimated time period to complete the flooring, which will be from Monday, July 31st through Friday, August 25th. There will be no Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament on First Friday, August 4th; nor Anointing or Benediction that evening. We are working with our various Ministries to accommodate as many requests for the Hall as possible, and we appreciate your flexibility during this time. We will keep you updated on the progress and will announce applicable information as it becomes available to us.

Attention: Ministers Of Adoration:

To conform to church guidelines for adoration, we need to be mindful of the regulation that requires that there be **no exposition** of the Blessed Sacrament **during Mass** celebrations in the same church. That means that the Blessed Sacrament monstrance cabinet should not be opened during Sunday Morning Masses, or during any other scheduled Masses celebrated in the main church. Please take care to observe this minimum limitation to our "Perpetual" adoration. Thank you.
