Fr. Ramon Marti Passes Away:

It is with great sadness that we learned of the passing of Fr. Ramon Marti, Sch.P., this past week. Fr. Ramon was 88 years of age. He was ordained a Piarist Father on June 29, 1955. He began his residency at Annunciation following his assignment as Chaplain at City of Hope in 1996, where he remained until 2000. He was instrumental in our Nocturnal Adoration program, Spanish Outreach and Ministries and assisted the parish with our weekly Spanish Mass, as well as many Quinceañeras. He was in Spain a few years ago when he fell and broke his hip, requiring surgery. It was determined then that he would remain there, to be near his sister, Teresa. Fr. Ramon was a great friend to many here at Annunciation. Please pray for the repose of his soul.

National Needs Collection This Weekend:

Mission Co-Op Next Weekend:

Sr. Daya Therese, DM, from the Daughters of Mary, will be present at all Masses next weekend, July 29th and 30th to speak to us about the sister's mission appeal. The sisters of the Daughters of Mary are from India and are currently residing in Monrovia with the Maryknoll Sisters. They believe in being pure and poor for the kingdom of God and they carry out their evangelization through family visits, health care, primary education and providing shelter homes for children, the aged and those with leprosy and AIDS.

Church Flooring Project To Begin:

Please be reminded that, due to the commencement of this project, all Masses and other church-related events will be moved to the Parish Hall for the estimated time period to complete the flooring, which will be from Monday, July 31st through Friday, August 25th. There will be no Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament on First Friday, August 4th; nor Anointing or Benediction that evening. We will keep you updated on the progress.

Attention: Ministers Of Adoration:

To conform to church guidelines for adoration, we need to be mindful of the regulation that requires that there be **no exposition** of the Blessed Sacrament **during Mass** celebrations in the same church. That means that the Blessed Sacrament monstrance cabinet should not be opened during Sunday Morning Masses, or during any other scheduled Masses celebrated in the main church. Please take care to observe this minimum limitation to our "Perpetual" adoration. Thank you.

Families returning for the second year of sacramental preparation must have all previous fees paid and copies of certificates must be in our office.
