Continuing our tradition of offering Mass on that day, and every anniversary day since then, this year's Mass will take place on Monday, Sept. 11th at 7:30 p.m. The youth of our parish (who were in infants in 2001), and who will host the Mass, demonstrate their faith in a powerful way as we come together on our National Day of Remembrance. All are welcome to come to this very special Mass to remember those whose lives were lost or forever changed. Religious Education Registration:
