Our 2018 Together in Mission drive begins today, with Fr. Eugene asking us this week to consider our pledge amount for this year's campaign. Next weekend, we will make our commitment to those parishes and schools in the Archdiocese of Los Angeles who rely on these funds to continue functioning in their respective communities. Please pray about this and come prepared next weekend to commit to help.

Lent Begins Wednesday, February 14th:

Ash Wednesday is February 14th. There will be Mass with Distribution of Ashes at 8:30 a.m.; **Distribution of Ashes only** at 12:00 Noon; a Spanish Mass with Distribution of Ashes at 5:00 p.m.; and a Mass with Distribution of Ashes at 7:30 p.m. Ash Wednesday is **not** a Holy Day of Obligation, but all are encouraged to faithfully begin the Lenten season by receiving ashes.

During Lent, there will be no Anointing of the Sick offered on First Fridays because Stations of the Cross will be observed before Benediction. There will be no Perpetual Help devotions offered on Ash Wednesday.

Ash Wednesday Vs. Valentine's Day:

With Valentine's Day and the beginning of Lent falling on the same day this year, it may be challenging to celebrate the one while simultaneously observing solemnly the other as we enter into Lent. Why not consider your Valentine's celebration on Valentine's Eve, Tuesday, Feb. 13th. It is, after all, the evening of the Carnival of Mardi Gras!

Basket In Vestibule For Palms To Be Burned:

Those wishing to bring their palms from last year's Palm Sunday liturgy to be burned for ashes to be used on Ash Wednesday, Feb. 14th, can place them in the baskets that are located in the vestibule of the church.

Lenten Schedule To Have Additional Liturgies:

An additional weekday Mass will be offered each Wednesday morning at 8:30 a.m., and Stations of the Cross will be observed every Friday evening at 7:30 p.m.

Lenten Discipline:

By Divine Law, as recorded in Sacred Scripture, the life of a Christian must be a life of penance. To encourage this ideal, the Church has set forth these rules and regulations for the observance of Lent:

- A. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence.
- B. All Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence only.

Church Law binds as follows:

- A. The Law of **Abstinence** (not eating meat) obliges those who have completed their 14th year.
- B. The law of **Fast** (only one full meal each day, the other two meals together being less than one full meal, with nothing between meals) obliges those who have completed their 21st year until the beginning of their 60th year.
- C. Grave inconvenience excuses from the laws of fast and abstinence.

Lenten Soup And Scripture To Begin:

Our Lenten Soup and Scripture will begin on Friday evening, Feb. 16th, in Conference Room 1 of the Parish Center. We will meet for a simple meal at 6:00 p.m. and will be invited to contribute to our Poor Box an amount that would constitute a full meal. We will finish in time for those wishing to attend Stations of the Cross at 7:30 p.m.
