## **Divine Mercy Feast Day and Novena To Be Celebrated Next Sunday:**

The Feast of the Divine Mercy will be observed on the 2nd Sunday of Easter, April 8th. All Masses that day celebrate the Divine Mercy that has saved us through the Death and Resurrection of Jesus. In special observance of this day, we will combine our Evening Prayer at 4:45 p.m. with the Divine Mercy Chanted Bi-lingual Chaplet, Procession, and Veneration of the Divine Mercy image, and Benediction. The spiritual blessing for those who observe the Feast of the Divine Mercy is promised to those who go to confession and receive Communion on that day. Confession celebrated at any time during Lent in preparation for Easter will suffice. The **Divine Mercy Novena** began with a privately-prayed Divine Mercy Novena, which immediately followed our 3:00 p.m. Celebration of the Lord's Passion. The Novena now continues for nine days at 3:00 p.m. each day until the Feast Day itself on April 8th. The Novena includes public recitation of the chaplet (with the exception of Good Friday) and on Easter, Exposition and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. All are welcome.

**Talk to children about all types of strangers**—Most children know something about stranger danger, but do they know about friendly strangers? No matter how friendly someone may be, children should know that if they don't know the person, they should never go anywhere with them. Give kids simple rules: it's okay to run away from someone you don't know, and to shout "No!" or "Go away!" if a stranger is talking to you or asking you to go anywhere.
