All Saints Day—A Holy Day Of Obligation:

This Thursday, Nov. 1st, is All Saints Day and is a Holy Day of Obligation. Masses will be celebrated at 8:30 a.m. and 7:30 p.m. that day. **Please Note: due to our regularly-scheduled Wednesday evening Mass, there will be NO Mass at 5:30 p.m. on Wednesday, Oct. 31st.** However, attendance at that Mass constitutes observance of the Holy Day. There will be the usual devotion to Our Lady of Perpetual Help following this Mass.

First Friday Changes for the Next Two Months Due to Special Celebrations:

The Sacrament of the Sick will not be celebrated for the next two months. Due to the parish All Souls Memorial Mass On Nov. 2nd, and the 5:30 p.m. Vigil Mass on Dec. 7th, our Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament that concludes our First Friday Adoration will be held earlier than usual and will not allow time necessary for the celebration of the Anointing which customarily accompanies Benediction. We apologize for this disappointment. The Anointing of the Sick will resume on the First Friday of January.

All Saints Day March:

All children are invited to join in our Annual All Saints Day March at the 7:30 p.m. Mass on Thursday, Nov. 1st. Choose the Saint you would like to honor—we have costumes you can use, or you can wear your own! You must learn a little about your Saint that you are representing! Christian Service Center News:

This November, we will be providing Thanksgiving funds for 165 families with residences, 12 homeless families and 117 homeless single adults.
